



 Mercator Projection Map = Distortion as you get farther away from the equator!






The Great Circle Route!






Map showing the countries of the world resized according to

Global Warming


- Believed to be caused in part by <u>human</u> activities such as burning coil, oil and gasses

Windward/Leeward side of mountains and the Rainshadow Effect






Types of Governments


- All government systems belong to 3 major groups:

 - Democracy rule by many people






